- Causing a dangerous condition such as ice buildup or flooding on either public or private property.
- There is danger that the sump pump or footing drain pipes will freeze up and result in either failure or damage to the sump pump unit or the footing drains and cause basement flooding.
- The water being discharged from the sump pump or footing drain cannot be readily discharged into a storm drain or other acceptable drainage system.

I hereby apply for a groundwater (sump pump) exception permit and I acknowledge that the information above is complete and accurate. I understand and agree that the use for which the permit is issued shall be performed according to: (1) Conditions of the permit; (2) The approved plans and specifications; (3) The applicable City ordinances and codes; and (4) The State building/plumbing codes and regulations.

I understand that this permit is not valid until signed and dated by a city representative, and that no clear water discharge into the municipal sanitary sewer system is allowable between November 16th and April 14th without a permit. Non-compliance will result in a fine of \$50.00.

I understand that the permit will become null and void if the property under which the permit is registered is found not to be in conformance with any of the conditions of the permit, or changes ownership.
