Lac qui Parle County Fair |

Robert Bly & Lac qui Parle County Historical Center |

The birthplace of Minnesota's best-selling author, Robert Bly. The Lac qui Parle County Historical Center features many items from Bly's youth as well as pioneer memorabilia, wildlife displays, Native American artifacts, the Ethel Mehlum Doll Collection, and more.

Madison Memorial Field | Memorial Field is home to the Madison Mallards, Eagles, Legion, and Junior Legion baseball programs. It is a lighted facility that is equipped with dugouts, concession stands, and parking.

Madison Country Club | Is open April through September, with Women's League on Tuesdays and Men's League on Thursdays. The facility features a nine-hole golf course situated on 40 acres, a full kitchen and bar, and dining room area.

Madison Speedway | Experience racing every Saturday night, from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Watch a variety of classes race, including Modifieds, Super Stocks, Midwest Modifieds, Street Stocks, Hornets, and more.

Slen Park | Slen Park offers a swimming pool with a large slide and toddler area, basketball and tennis courts, shelters, walking trail, and a playground.

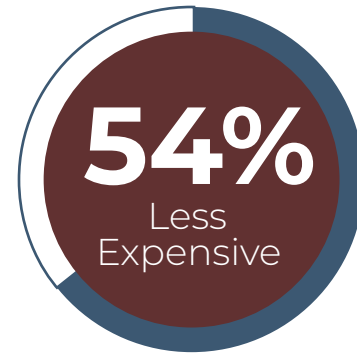
Madison's own Lac qui Parle Players provide community theatre entertainment featuring local and national talent.
